Dayton Area Attractions

1. National Museum of the United States Air Force

- **Description:** The largest and oldest military aviation museum in the world, featuring a vast collection of aircraft, missiles, and aviation history exhibits.
- **Cost:** Free admission, but donations are appreciated.
- **Hours:** 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM daily (closed on holidays).

2. Carillon Historical Park

- **Description:** A 65-acre outdoor museum showcasing the history of Dayton, including the Wright Brothers and early aviation, the Carillon Bell Tower, and much more.
- **Cost:** \$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors (60+), \$8 for children (3-17), free for members and children under 3.
- **Hours:** 9:30 AM - 5:00 PM (check for seasonal hours).

3. The Dayton Art Institute

- **Description:** A renowned art museum offering a variety of exhibits ranging from European to contemporary art, as well as special events and programs.
- **Cost:** \$14 for adults, \$12 for seniors (60+), \$6 for students, free for members and children under 6.
- **Hours:** 11:00 AM - 5:00 PM (check for seasonal hours).

4. Wright Brothers National Memorial

- **Description:** A park dedicated to the Wright Brothers and their first successful powered flight, featuring a replica of their 1903 Wright Flyer and exhibits on their achievements.
- **Cost:** Free, though there is an entry fee for parking if visiting the memorial site.
- **Hours:** 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

5. Five Rivers MetroParks

- **Description:** A network of parks, nature reserves, and trails offering outdoor recreation such as hiking, kayaking, disc golf, and biking.
- **Cost:** Free, though some activities may require rentals or special fees.
- **Hours:** Varies by park.

6. The Oregon District

- **Description:** Dayton's oldest neighborhood, featuring historic architecture, unique shops, restaurants, bars, and entertainment venues.
- **Cost:** Free to explore, but shopping or dining will have costs.
- **Hours:** Shops and restaurants open during typical business hours.

7. Aullwood Audubon Center and Farm

- **Description:** An environmental education center offering hiking trails, farm animals, bird watching, and interactive exhibits.
- **Cost:** \$9 for adults, \$7 for seniors, \$6 for children (3-18).
- **Hours:** 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM daily (seasonal hours).

8. SunWatch Indian Village/Archaeological Park

- **Description:** A prehistoric Native American village site with a reconstructed fort and archaeological exhibits.
- **Cost:** \$8 for adults, \$6 for seniors (60+), \$4 for children (3-17), free for children under 3.
- **Hours:** 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM (check for seasonal hours).

9. The Greene

- **Description:** A large outdoor shopping center with a mix of shops, restaurants, and entertainment options.
- **Cost:** Free to visit, but shopping or dining will have costs.
- **Hours:** Open during typical mall hours (10:00 AM - 9:00 PM).

10. Dayton Dragons Baseball Game (at Day Air Ballpark)

- **Description:** Watch the Dayton Dragons, a Minor League Baseball team, play in the heart of downtown Dayton.
- **Cost:** \$10 to \$30 per ticket, depending on seating and game day.

11. Hollywood Gaming Dayton Raceway

- **Description:** A casino and racetrack featuring gaming options, live/simulcast harness racing, and dining.
- **Cost:** Free admission; costs depend on gaming and dining choices.
- **Hours:** 24/7.

Note that prices are approximate and may vary. It's always a good idea to check the official website or contact the venues for the most up-to-date information on hours, costs, and any potential discounts or special offers.
